

Casimiro to Sana

From Casimiro Bus Station, take the bus to Sana. The bus drives every hour and a half and takes around 45 minutes. It is a large, local bus and you can buy the ticket on the bus.

“Please where can I take a bus to Sana?”

“Por Favor aonde pego o ônibus para o Sana? “

The bus leaves Casimiro and starts driving up the mountains. After 16km it leaves the asphalt road and turns off onto a bumpy dirt road. After about 8km, the bus enters the tiny village of Sana.

The road surface become stone. You will pass a wooden bridge on the left, and a small health post on the right with a mini-roundabout in front of it. The bus stop to get off is about 50m after the health post.

Just past the bus stop is a Catholic church on the right, with grass and a fence around, and opposite this is a wide fence with a large sign saying “Cria Sana”.

If we agreed to meet in Sana, the meeting point is here.

The best is to ask the driver beforehand to let you off there:

“Please can you tell me when we arrive at Cria Sana?”

“Por favor pode me deixar no Cria Sana? “

- Remind the driver once you enter Sana.
